Program Requirements

Students entering the Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing program must have a bachelor's degree in any field from an accredited institution of higher learning. Depending on the courses completed during their bachelor's degree, students may qualify to begin the nursing program immediately. Others may need to complete the following pre-requisite courses:

- Academic Writing & Research
- Anatomy & Physiology I & II
- Psychology or Sociology
- Statistics
- Public Speaking & Communications
- Microbiology

Full Tuition Reimbursement Paired with 100% Job Placement

Thanks to the support of Parkview Health, students in the first cohort of classes that begin in August 2023 are eligible to receive substantial up-front tuition support and additional education loan forgiveness with a promised career as a clinical nurse at Parkview Health. The Parkview ABSN Scholarship program is available to all students who successfully complete the nursing degree program and commit to working at Parkview Health upon finishing their studies. Tuition benefits are paid over time, so the longer a graduate works at Parkview, the more their tuition is covered. The result: students who work at Parkview for three years or more will have their tuition covered for them. Tuition and Fees

The Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing program is a full-time, inperson 13 month program taught by Huntington University on Indiana Tech's main campus in Fort Wayne. Clinicals take place at Parkview Health locations in Northeast Indiana. Students successfully complete 56 total credit hours in order to earn a bachelor's of science degree in nursing from Huntington University.
