

Lutheran Health medical office taking shape

The new Lutheran Health Network's (LHN) medical office has begun to take shape over the past few weeks in Huntington. The new primary care clinic is located at 235 Hauenstein Road, Huntington.

The new medical office building will provide primary care, imaging services as well as rotating medical specialists. The facility is expected to open for patient care by late summer 2024. Construction on the 8,000 square foot project has begun. It is the first Lutheran Health Network facility in Huntington.

"This new site will increase access to quality healthcare services for Huntington and the surrounding area," said Nicole Rexroth, CEO, Lutheran Health Physicians. "A large number of residents from this area travel to other Lutheran Health Physician locations for care. This new site will allow them to have access to our medical services close to where they live and work."

According to Nick Alwine, president, FCI Construction, "The LHN Huntington Project is on schedule to be completed this summer. We continue to closely track lead times of mechanical and electrical equipment as the world continues to grapple with complex supply chain constraints and whether those will impact this date — which thus far does not appear to be the case. We recently have finished exterior wall construction and sheathing as well as underground plumbing and interior concrete slabs. The exterior masonry, windows and roofing products will be installed over the next few weeks as well the start of the interior walls and fitout."

"FCI Construction has been thrilled with the continued partnership with Lutheran Health Network, Lutheran Health Physicians, and Veritas Realty as we collectively deliver this facility, and service, to the Huntington community. We continue to look to ways we can increase our footprint in Huntington, a decision driven by the great people we have met and the relationships we have built throughout the community," said Alwine.

The general contractor for the project is FCI Construction and Veritas is the developer.

Ivy Tech plans \$60M in capital projects

The Ivy Tech Community College board of trustees on Thursday approved a \$60 million capital improvement project on its Fort Wayne campus. The project includes a new nursing and health sciences facility, as well as renovations to college's Coliseum Campus.

The board voted to issue bonds up to \$60 million to finance the project, which Ivy Tech president Sue Ellspermann said has been a capital

priority for board chair Andrew Wilson said is being made possible because of Ivy Tech's strong financial position.

Plans call for the construction of a 50,000-square-foot nursing and health sciences facility that Ivy Tech said will help address a nursing shortage in the region.

The college said the facility will allow the campus to increase enrollment in the Schools of Health Sciences and Nursing by at least 7% and boost completion of high-quality health care certificates, credentials and degrees by 20%.

The project will include the renovation and modernization of the Coliseum Campus, which is the main hub for Ivy Tech Fort Wayne. The effort will focus on increasing instructional lab space and reducing overall square footage, which the college said will provide operational savings of more than \$600,000.

said in a news release. "This project will allow our campus to provide a learning experience that mirrors what students will encounter in a modern industry setting while enhancing our support services."

Additional plans for the project include demolishing Harshman and Carroll halls, which were built in 1965; unifying student enrollment and support services into a single facility; and streamlining administrative office space to reflect a hybrid work environment.

The project must be reviewed by the Indiana Commission for Higher Education and State Budget Committee before construction can begin.

Ivy Tech aims to break ground in 2025.

Ivy Tech Fort Wayne is the college's second-largest campus and serves more than 19,000 students from Adams, Allen, Dekalb, Huntington, Kosciusko, LaGrange, Noble, Steuben, Wabash, Wells and Whitley counties.




