Thank you Huntington!

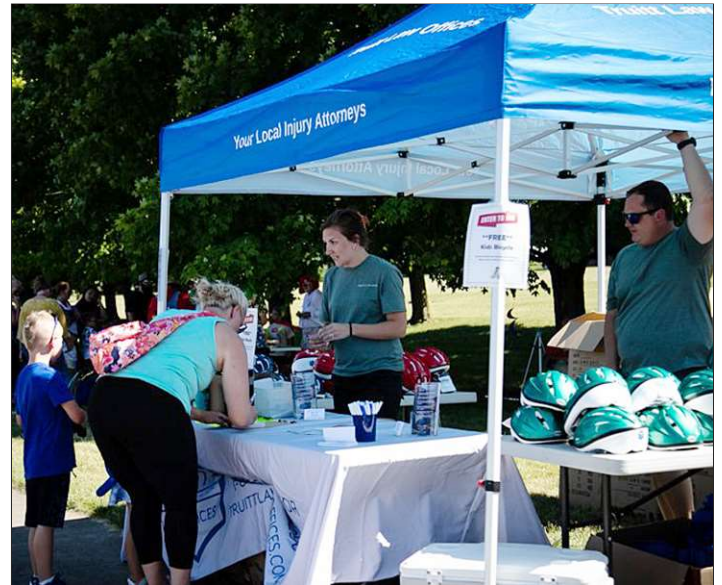
