SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTION FORM

Tri Kappa, Chi Chapter-Huntington is proud to provide local scholarships to high school seniors wishing to pursue a college education. Selection is based upon academics, ability and financial need. Applicants must be residents of Huntington County.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

General Scholarship: Must be a high school senior planning to graduate in the spring and continue their education at a post-secondary institution.

Laura Blackburn Scholarship: High school senior planning to graduate in the spring and continue their education at a post-secondary institution or a college student actively enrolled in undergraduate studies with intention to achieve a degree in education.

Note: If you are applying for both the General and the Laura Blackburn Scholarships, only one application needs to be completed. Be sure to check both boxes indicating you are applying for both.

1. Indicate the scholarship you are applying for this year (General or Laura Blackburn).
2. Attach a recent photo to the top left corner of page one of the application form.
3. Ask three teachers to complete the attached recommendation form. Ask them to return the completed form to you or to forward it to the Scholarship Chair. *(Provide an envelope for mailing.)
4. Include at least one letter of reference from someone outside the school system who is familiar with your goals and achievements. This person should not be a relative.
5. Complete the "Parent Confidential Statement."
6. Attach an essay of 500 words or less on the following topic:
 - a. For the General Scholarship: "Why I am pursuing a college degree and why I have chosen this field of study."
 - b. For the Laura Blackburn Scholarship: "Why I want to become a teacher."
7. Include your most recent transcript.

**As a courtesy to any teacher or counselor who has agreed to fill out a recommendation form/letter and wishes to mail it directly to the scholarship committee, provide a stamped envelope addressed to:

Indicate in the lower left side of the envelope which scholarship the recommendation is to be directed: Tri Kappa General Scholarship or Laura Blackburn Scholarship.

The completeness of this application will be taken into consideration when selecting scholarship recipients. If recommendation forms are being mailed directly to the chair, please indicate that on a separate sheet of paper.
